



Rotowiper works because it has a unique rotating roller covered with a carpet that is specifically manufactured and tested for Rotowiper. Herbicide is applied to the carpet within the confines of a set of shields, making spray drift a problem of the past. The combination of an adjustable height and rotating roller means you only apply herbicide to the targeted weeds, not your pasture or crop. Herbicide is directly rolled onto the underside of the leaf, which is the most vulnerable part of the plant. This of course gives a better kill and less herbicide is used.

Towing Options

It's easy to tow! The Rotowiper only weighs 223 lbs with an empty tank and 321 lbs with a full tank. It is suitable for towing behind OHVs, trucks, utility vehicles and tractors.

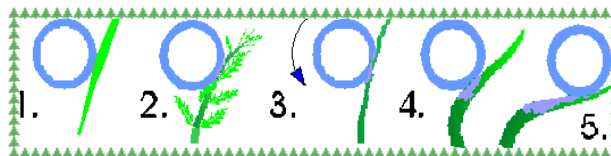
Rotowiper - The Original Rotowiping System



How it Works

Rotowiper uses a unique carpeted drum which rotates in the opposite direction of travel. This movement insures that the roller has a constant supply of herbicide, which in turn is brushed on to your targeted weeds.

As the roller rotates, it applies the herbicide to the stem and the underside of the leaf, this being one of the more receptive areas for the weed to absorb the herbicide.



This means you are only applying the herbicide to the most effective kill area of the plant.



Underneath the stripe of dead smutgrass is live dallisgrass where the herbicide was applied using Rotowiper. Smutgrass is still growing along the left and right sides of the photo where the Rotowiper wasn't used.

Availability

The Rotowiper is available for rent from the RCD of Tehama County by the day or week. The RCD also provides the Rotowiper as a service. An operator will come out to the area of interest with a UTV and apply the herbicide for you.
