



## Request for Proposals Equipment Rental

Notice is hereby given that the Resource Conservation District of Tehama County will receive Request for Proposals for equipment rentals on **August 1<sup>st</sup> 2025**, before **5:00 PM PST** at 202 Walnut Street, Red Bluff, Ca 96080 or submitted electronically to Drew Barnhart, Project Manager II - [dbarnhart@tehamacountyrcd.org](mailto:dbarnhart@tehamacountyrcd.org). Any proposal received after the time and date listed above will be returned unopened.

**Proposal Opening Date:** July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 4:00 PM at 202 Walnut Street, Red Bluff, Ca 96080.

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Resource Conservation District of Tehama County (RCDTC) is looking for proposals to rent equipment, heavy equipment and portable toilets for various conservation related projects including (but not limited to) Forestry and Fuels Reduction work in Tehama County. The RCDTC is open to accepting proposals from multiple vendors and awarding separate contracts. Examples of project work include (but not limited to) roadside fuel breaks, mastication, chipping woody debris/biomass, and herbicide application. This shall be a recurring Request for Proposals - open and continuous. Future openings and announcements of award dates will be noted in addendums to this notice, estimated recurrence on a 6-month interval.

**\*NOTE:** Projects often are conducted in conditions including extreme weather (below freezing and/or above 100°F), dusty or sandy work sites, post fire landscapes, river/riparian landscapes, steep elevation. Please integrate potential related costs into cost(s) estimates.

### LOGISTICS

- ❖ RCDTC will provide liability insurance for rented equipment.
- ❖ Invoicing requirements and reimbursement.
  - RCDTC requires invoices to be submitted by the 10th of the month after services/rental rendered.

- RCDTC reviews, compiles and submits invoices to funder usually between the 15th – 20th of the month after services/rental rendered.
- Grant funders can take up to 6+ months for final review and disbursement of payment. (*Please incorporate potential anticipated delay in payment into consideration when calculating rates*).
- RCDTC Sample Equipment Rental agreement attached as attachment B.  
\*NOTE: Use of Contractor’s default contract is acceptable if it can be amended to include necessary terms or conditions for RCDTC. In this circumstance RCDTC will provide list of necessary terms and conditions.

**Non-Discrimination:** The Contractor selected through this RFP shall provide services without discrimination based on race, creed, color, ethnic or linguistic identification, gender or sexual preference, disability or handicap or any other basis prohibited by law.

**Conflict of Interest:** Vendor covenants that it presently has no interest and shall not acquire an interest, direct or indirect, financial or otherwise, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of the services hereunder. Vendor further covenants that, in the performance of this Contract, no subcontractor or person having such an interest shall be used or employed. Vendor certifies that no one who has or will have any financial interest under this Contract is an officer or employee of the RCDTC.

**Award of Contract:** The RCDTC intends to award a contract to the Contractor who best meets the RCDTC’s requirements. Proposals will be evaluated for “best value” not necessarily “lowest price”.

**Best Value Approach:**

- ❖ The Selection Evaluation Team shall be responsible for performing the evaluations of each proposal. Best approach determination

shall be the evaluation method used when considering criteria other than merely cost. Each member of the team shall rate the proposers separately. The scores of each of the team members shall then be combined to provide a total score for each of the proposers. The proposals shall be evaluated based on the following categories and the maximum weight possible for each category is listed below:

## **TIMELINE**

- ❖ Equipment rental rates will be for duration extending 2 years from proposal close date. (Please integrate inflation or ancillary costs anticipated during extended timeframe).
- ❖ This shall be a recurring Request for Proposals - open and continuous. Future openings and announcements of award dates will be noted in addendums to this notice, estimated reoccurrence on a 6-month interval.

## **CONTRACT AWARD**

- ❖ The RCDTC reserves the right to award multiple contracts as a result of this Request for Proposals(RFP). Rate contracts must be awarded and executed by the Resource Conservation District of Tehama County. Award will be given to those qualified proposers whose proposal(s) will be the most advantageous to the RCDTC, with cost and all other factors considered.
- ❖ If the RCDTC cannot successfully negotiate a contract with the highest ranked proposer, the RCDTC will terminate negotiations and begin negotiations with the next highest ranked proposer. Proposers will receive emailed Award/Non-Award notification(s) which will include the name of the proposer to be awarded this contract. Proposers are advised that the RCDTC reserves the following prerogatives:
  - To reject any or all proposals
  - To consider historic information and fact, whether gained from the proposer's proposal or any other source, in the evaluation process, and
  - The proposer is cautioned that it is the proposer's sole responsibility to submit information related to the evaluation categories and the RCDTC is under no obligation to solicit such information if it is not included with the proposal. Failure of the individual or firm to submit such information may have an adverse impact on the evaluation of the proposal.
- ❖ If the RCDTC cannot successfully negotiate a contract with the highest ranked proposal within two weeks, the next highest ranked proposal will be selected and notified.

## **COSTS OF DEVELOPING PROPOSALS**

- ❖ Any and all costs incurred in the preparation of a proposal are the responsibility of each proposer and will not be reimbursed by RCDTC, nor will grant funds be used for such reimbursement.

## PROTEST/APPEAL PROCESS

- ❖ The following procedure is provided in the event that a proposer wishes to protest the RFB evaluation and selection process or appeal the recommendation to award a contract once the Notices of Award/Non-Award have been issued.
  - Any protest must be submitted in writing to the RDCTC mailing address PO box 1232, Red Bluff, CA 96080. Attention: Jon Barrett. RCDTC District Manager
  - The protest must be submitted or postmarked before 6:00 PM on the 5th calendar day following the date of the Notice of Award.
  - The protest must contain a complete statement of the basis for the protest. The protest must include the name, address, telephone number and e-mail address of the person representing the protesting party.
  - The procedure and time limits are mandatory and are the proposer's sole and exclusive remedy in the event of a proposal protest.
  - Proposer's failure to comply with these procedures shall constitute a waiver of any right to further pursue the protest, including filing a claim or legal proceedings.
  - Upon receipt of written protest/appeal, the RCDTC will review and provide an opportunity to settle the protest/appeal by mutual agreement, will schedule a meeting to discuss or issue a written response to advise of an appeal/protest decision within 20 business days of receipt of the appeal/protest.

## PUBLIC RECORDS ACCESS

- ❖ Proposers should be aware that submitted proposals are subject to the California Public Records Act and may be disclosed to members of the public upon request. ***It is the responsibility of the proposers to clearly identify information in their proposals that they consider to be confidential under the California Public Records Act.*** To the extent that the RCDTC agrees with that designation, such information will be held in confidence whenever possible. All other information will be considered public. All information regarding the proposals will be held as confidential until such time as the Selection Committee has completed its evaluation and, or if, contract negotiations are completed.

## ATTACHMENT B Equipment Lease Agreement

This Equipment Lease Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered on 10-9-2022, by and between EXAMPLE.CO ("Lessor") and Resource Conservation District of Tehama County ("Lessee") (collectively referred to as the "Parties").

The Parties agree as follows:

**1. EQUIPMENT:** Lessor hereby leases to Lessee the following equipment: (the "Equipment").

1. 2016 Link Belt 160X4 Excavator SN: XXXXXXXXXXXX
2. 2006 Ford F350 Super Duty VIN: XXXXXXXXXX, License Plate: XXXXXXXX
3. 2021 Wylie 500 gal. Water Trailer VIN: XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX
4. Prinoth M450E-1100 42" Hydraulic Mulcher Attachment
5. Chain Saw
6. Backpack Blower

**2. LEASE TERM:** The lease will start on 10-09-2022 (begin date) and will end on 10-09-2023 (end date) (Lease Term).

**3. LEASE PAYMENTS:** Lessee agrees to pay to Lessor the following daily rates for the equipment:

1. 2016 Link Belt 160X4 Excavator SN: XXXXXXXXXXXX - \$1500 per day
2. 2006 Ford F350 Super Duty VIN: XXXXXXXXXX, License#: XXXXXX - \$300 per day
3. 2021 Wylie 500 gal. Water Trailer VIN: XXXXXXXXXX \$300 per day
4. Prinoth M450E-1100 42" Hydraulic Mulcher Attachment - \$1400 per day
5. Chain Saw - \$100 per day
6. Backpack Blower \$60 per day

Lessor will track daily rental of equipment to be billed. Fuel costs will be the responsibility of the Lessee.

4. **INVOICING:** Lessor shall invoice the Lessee once a month in arrears. All invoicing is due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month to ensure prompt invoicing payment. Invoices will include Lessor's name, all prudent contact information, invoice number. Invoices will contain the month for which the equipment is being billed, the equipment identified, delivery cost.
5. **PAYMENT:** Lessor is aware that payment for equipment rental is being funded by grant funding and Lessee will pay any undisputed invoice 14 days after Lessee receives funding from the grant funder.
6. **DELIVERY:** Lessee shall pay Lessor a rate of \$175 per hour for delivery and return of the equipment. Lessee shall pay Lessor a one-time cleaning fee of \$450 upon delivery. Once equipment is turned back over to Lessor at the job site, Lessor will be responsible for any damage that may result from loading/unloading of equipment and transportation of equipment to and from the job site.
7. **POSSESSION AND SURRENDER OF EQUIPMENT:** Lessee shall be entitled to possession of the Equipment on the first day of the Lease Term. At the expiration of the Lease Term, Lessee shall surrender the Equipment to Lessor by delivering the equipment to Lessor or Lessor's agent in good condition and working order, ordinary wear and tear excepted, as it was at the commencement of the Agreement.
8. **USE OF EQUIPMENT:** Lessor is aware that the equipment will be used for fuel reduction and forest health projects, which includes mastication and tree removal. Lessee shall only use the equipment in a careful and proper manner and will comply with all laws, rules, ordinances, statutes and orders regarding the use, maintenance and storage of the equipment.
9. **CONDITION OF EQUIPMENT AND REPAIR:** Lessee or Lessee's agent has inspected the equipment and acknowledges that the equipment is in good and acceptable condition.
10. **MAINTENANCE, DAMAGE AND LOSS:** Lessor will, at Lessor's sole expense, keep and maintain the equipment in clean and good working order and repair during the Lease Term. Lessor is also responsible for any normal wear and tear, and replacement of consumable parts. In the event the equipment is lost or damaged beyond repair for normal operations, Lessee shall pay to Lessor the market value of the equipment.
11. **INSURANCE:** Lessee shall be responsible to maintain insurance on the equipment with losses payable to Lessor against fire, theft, collision, and other such risks as are appropriate and specified by Lessor. Upon request by Lessor, Lessee shall provide proof of such insurance. Lessor also ensures that it has all proper and sufficient insurance for the equipment being rented, including auto insurance on vehicles being rented to the Lessee
12. **ENCUMBRANCES, TAXES AND OTHER LAWS:** Lessee shall keep the equipment free and clear of any liens or other encumbrances and shall not permit any act where Lessor's title or rights may be negatively affected. Lessee shall be

responsible for complying with and conforming to all laws and regulations relating to the possession, use or maintenance of the equipment. Lessor shall be responsible for and promptly pay all taxes, fees, licenses, and governmental charges, together with any penalties or interest thereon, relating to the ownership, use or maintenance of the equipment.

13. **LESSOR’S REPRESENTATIONS:** Lessor represents and warrants that he/she has the right to lease the equipment as provided in this Agreement and that Lessee shall be entitled to quietly hold and possess the equipment, and Lessor will not interfere with that right as long as Lessee pays the rent in a timely manner and performs all other obligations under this Agreement.

14. **OWNERSHIP:** The equipment is and shall remain the exclusive property of Lessor.

15. **SEVERABILITY:** If any part or parts of this Agreement shall be held unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. If any provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, and if limiting such provision would make the provision valid, then such provision shall be deemed to be construed as so limited.

16. **ASSIGNMENT:** Neither this Agreement nor Lessee’s rights hereunder are assignable except with Lessor’s prior, written consent.

17. **SUBSTITUTION:** Lessor may not substitute, or trade out equipment, until acknowledged by Lessee that substitute equipment will meet operational needs.

18. **BINDING EFFECT:** The covenants and conditions contained in the Agreement shall apply to and bind the Parties and the heirs, legal representatives, successors and permitted assigns of the Parties.

19. **GOVERNING LAW:** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.

20. **NOTICE:** Any notice required or otherwise given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and mailed certified return receipt requested, postage prepaid, or delivered by overnight delivery service to:

Either party may change such addresses from time to time by providing notice as set forth above.

21. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT:** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes any prior understanding or representation of any kind preceding the date of this Agreement. There are no other promises, conditions, understandings, or other agreements, whether oral or written, relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. This Agreement may be modified in writing and must be signed by both Lessor and Lessee.
22. **CUMULATIVE RIGHTS:** Lessor's and Lessee's rights under this Agreement are cumulative and shall not be construed as exclusive of each other unless otherwise required by law.
23. **WAIVER:** The failure of either party to enforce any provisions of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver or limitation of that party's right to subsequently enforce and compel strict compliance with every provision of this Agreement. The acceptance of rent by Lessor does not waive Lessor's right to enforce any provisions of this Agreement.
24. **INDEMNIFICATION:** Except for damages, claims or losses due to Lessor's acts or negligence, Lessee, to the extent permitted by law, will indemnify and hold Lessor and Lessor's property, free and harmless from any liability for losses, claims, injury to or death of any person, including Lessee, or for damage to property arising from Lessee using and possessing the Equipment or from the acts or omissions of any person or persons, including Lessee, using or possessing the Equipment with Lessee's express or implied consent.
25. **RIGHT TO SUSPEND OR TERMINATE:** Lessee may suspend or terminate this Agreement for any reason with or without cause by giving fifteen (15) days written notice to Lessor. On receipt of such notice, Lessor shall immediately arrange for possession of equipment. On such suspension or termination, Lessor shall be paid for all equipment rental rendered to Lessee to the date of the suspension or termination; provided, however if this Agreement is suspended or terminated for fault of Lessor, Lessee shall be obligated to compensate Lessor only for that portion of Lessor's services which are of benefit to Lessee.
