

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RESOURCE  
CONSERVATION DISTRICT OF TEHAMA COUNTY ADOPTING THE PROJECT-  
SPECIFIC ANALYSIS AND ADDENDUM FOR THE TEHAMA WILDLIFE AREA  
VEGETATION TREATMENT PROJECT PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA  
VEGETATION TREATMENT PROGRAM (CalVTP) AND CEQA GUIDELINES  
SECTION 15164**

**RESOLUTION #2026-03**

WHEREAS, the Resource Conservation District of Tehama County (“RCDTC”) is a public agency organized and existing under the laws of the State of California; and  
WHEREAS, in 2019, the California Board of Forestry and Fire Protection certified the Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) for the California Vegetation Treatment Program (CalVTP) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

WHEREAS, the CalVTP PEIR provides program-level environmental review and a tiering framework for qualifying vegetation treatment projects; and

WHEREAS, the Tehama Wildlife Area Vegetation Treatment Project proposes vegetation treatments on approximately 40,327 acres of lands owned and managed by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife within the Tehama Wildlife Area in Tehama County; and

WHEREAS, RCDTC is serving as the Lead Agency for purposes of CEQA for the Project; and

WHEREAS, a Project-Specific Analysis (PSA) has been prepared pursuant to the CalVTP PEIR to evaluate the Project’s environmental effects and confirm that the Project is within the scope of the PEIR; and

WHEREAS, the PSA concludes that the Project is within the scope of the CalVTP PEIR, all applicable Standard Project Requirements and mitigation measures will be implemented, and no new or substantially more severe impacts would occur; and

WHEREAS, an Addendum has been prepared pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15164 to address inclusion of acreage outside the originally mapped CalVTP treatable landscape and minor revisions to SPR AQ-4 and SPR HAZ-1; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concludes that none of the conditions described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 requiring preparation of a subsequent or supplemental EIR are present; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has independently reviewed and considered the CalVTP PEIR, the PSA, and the Addendum prior to taking action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Resource Conservation District of Tehama County hereby finds and determines as follows:  
The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

1. The Tehama Wildlife Area Vegetation Treatment Project is within the scope of the CalVTP Program Environmental Impact Report.
2. The Project-Specific Analysis and Addendum have been completed in compliance with CEQA and CEQA Guidelines Section 15164.
3. None of the conditions described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 requiring preparation of a subsequent or supplemental EIR are present.
4. The Board hereby adopts the Project-Specific Analysis and Addendum for the Tehama Wildlife Area Vegetation Treatment Project.
5. The District Manager is authorized and directed to file a Notice of Determination in accordance with CEQA and to take such other actions as may be necessary to implement this Resolution.


