Project Description: The Resource Conservation District of Tehama County is proposing to remove 80,000 cubic yards of sediment from a licensed and permitted agricultural pond impacted by the McFarland Fire, restore the pond's aquatic habitat, and revegetate and stabilize surrounding uplands. Work will be completed during the dry season and will take approximately 60 working days and may occur for more than one year depending on the availability of funds.

This is to advise that the RCDTC Board of Directors approved the above-described project on March 4, 2026, and has made the following determinations regarding the project:

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A **Mitigated Negative Declaration** was prepared and adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

4. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) **was** adopted for this project.
